## 2023 School Fees

### **Enrolments**

Application Fee per child - \$100

Acceptance Fee per child (Without Health Care Card) - \$800

Acceptance Fee per child (With Health Care Card) - \$400

Non-refundable and Non-transferrable

Health Care Card must be valid at the time of acceptance of enrolment

### **Tuition Fees**

Foundation to Year 6: \$3,308

Year 7 to Year 10: \$3,624

Year 11 and Year 12 (**VCE**): \$3,960

Year 11 and Year 12 (**IB**): \$5,200

### **Sibling Discount**

One child – Full Fee

Two or more children – 10% discount for the 2<sup>nd</sup> child and subsequent children

Every 5<sup>th</sup> child enrolled qualifies for a 100% discount on school fees only

### **Health Care Card Discount**

Foundation to Year 6: \$400

Year 7 to Year 12: \$500

Health Care Card must be provided within the first two weeks of Term 1 or within two weeks of the date of issue of the card.

Upfront discount of 10% provided on both School Fees and Extra Curricular Activities if the whole year is paid by week 4 of Term 1. Only a 5% discount is provided if paid by the end of Term 1. This discount is given on the full amount after all other discounts (if applicable) are applied.

### **Extra-curricular activities**

Foundation to Year 4: \$300

Year 5 and 7: \$550 \*

Year 6, 9 and 12: \$850 \*\*

Year 8, 10 and 11: \$350

\*Extra-Curricular activities fees include School Camp/Sports Excursion fees for year levels 5, and 7.

\*\* Extra-Curricular activities fees include School Canberra trip for year 6. For year 9, it includes the School Camp, First Aid Training, Orienteering, and other extra-curricular activities. For year 12, it includes the Study Camp and other extra-curricular activities.

## **IT Levy**

### **For students joining ICOM in Year 7 or earlier**

- \$419.10 per term in Terms 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Year 7
- \$419.10 per term in Terms 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Year 10

### **For students joining ICOM in Year 8**

- \$419.10 per term in Terms 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Year 8
- \$419.10 per term in Terms 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Year 11

### **For students joining ICOM in Year 9 or later**

- \$419.10 per term in Terms 1, 2, 3 and 4 of their first year of school

**Note:** In case a student leaves the school before paying the full IT Levy, they will be liable to pay the full IT Levy within 2 weeks of their last day at school. No laptop will be returned.

## **Re-enrolment for 2023**

Re-enrolment Fee per family (Without Health Care Card) - \$300

Re-enrolment Fee per family (With Health Care Card) - \$200

Every family with child/ren continuing the following year is required to pay the re-enrolment fee by the end of Term 2.

This fee is non-refundable.

All fees are subject to change without notice.

## **Building Levy**

The College recommends an optional building levy per family of \$500 or any other amount. The payments are tax deductible and dedicated for future buildings and expansion projects. Receipts for building levy and donations made to this account can be provided by the College upon request.

## **International Student Fees**

Foundation to Year 12: \$18,500

## **Payment of Fees:**

All fees are payable within the first two weeks of each term. However, for Year 12 students, the whole year's fees including Term 4 fees should be paid by the second week of Term 3.

Preferred method of payment is BPAY or Parent Portal (SEQTA Engage).

Payments can also be made at the Administration office or deposited directly into the school bank account.

## **Student Enrolment Bond (SEB)**

The SEB is an interest free deposit of \$500 per student, up to a maximum of \$1000 per family, and will be refunded on written request, when a student leaves the Islamic College of Melbourne. This is subject to all financial commitments having been settled and the required notice of withdrawal being given. If not claimed within 6 months of a student leaving, the SEB will be transferred to the school building fund and deemed as a donation to the School.

## **Withdrawal of enrolment:**

A Student Withdrawal Form will need to be completed and handed to the administration office should you wish to withdraw your child from the Islamic College of Melbourne.

Parents/guardians should provide one full term's notice prior to their child/ren's last day at the school should they wish to withdraw their child from the college. If the child/ren has not commenced at the Islamic College of Melbourne, parents/guardians should provide one full term's notice prior to their scheduled commencement at the college.

If one full terms notice is not received, parents/guardians will be liable to pay one full term school fees for the current and following term.
